ELC is especially being set up in colleges all across India targeting the new voters (in the age group of 18-21 years old) pursuing their graduation.

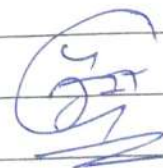
Objectives of the Club

4. To harness the potential of ELC members for carrying the electoral literacy in communities;
5. To facilitate voter registration for its eligible members who are yet registered;

Activity-1 ('Voter Helpline App')

Today i.e. 20-08-2022 a Seminar on topic "Voter Helpline App" was Conducted by ELC Sugh-Bhatoli in the premises of Govt. Degree college, Sugh-Bhatoli in which students of the College were made aware about the Android based Application "VOTER HELPLINE" APP available on Play store. Prof. Rohit Garchi explained all the features of the application like Candidate Information, Electoral Roll, EVM, Voter Registration etc. Further, he motivated the students to apply for their new Voter Card through this app.

Prof. Rajesh Kumar in his talk told the students that the election Commission of India has modified the cut off date for the eligibility of making Voter Card. Now anyone who is above 18 years or going to attain the age of 18 yrs on below mentioned dates is eligible to apply for Voter Card. The dates are 1 Jan, 1 April, 1 July & 1 Oct. The Seminar ends with the vote of thanks from Prof. Jagan.

Activity 2 (NVSIP website & Procedure involving in Election)
