Imposed restriction includes-
 The designated sensitive zone is defined from 50 m to 2 km around the sanctuary. The sensitive zone extends 50 meters to 2 km around the sanctuary, with strict regulations on commercial mining, pollution, deforestation, and major development projects.

Provided that the conversion of agricultural and other lands, for the purposes other than that specified at part (a) above, within the Eco-sensitive Zone may be permitted on the recommendation of the Monitoring Committee, and with the prior approval of the competent authority under Regional Town Planning Act and other rules and regulations of Central Government or State Government as applicable and vide provisions of this notification, to meet the residential needs of the local residents and for activities, such as :-

- (i) widening and strengthening of existing roads and construction of new roads
- (ii) construction and renovation of infrastructure and civic amenities
- (iii) small scale industries not causing pollution
- (iv) cottage industries including village industries, convenience stores and local amenities supporting eco-tourism including home stay etc.

Natural water bodies.
 The catchment areas of all natural springs shall be identified and plans for their conservation and rejuvenation shall be incorporated in the ZOT. Plans for conservation and rejuvenation shall be drawn up by the State Government in such a manner as to prohibit development activities at or near these areas which are detrimental to such areas.

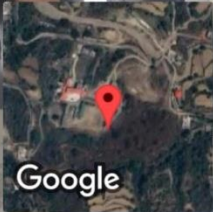

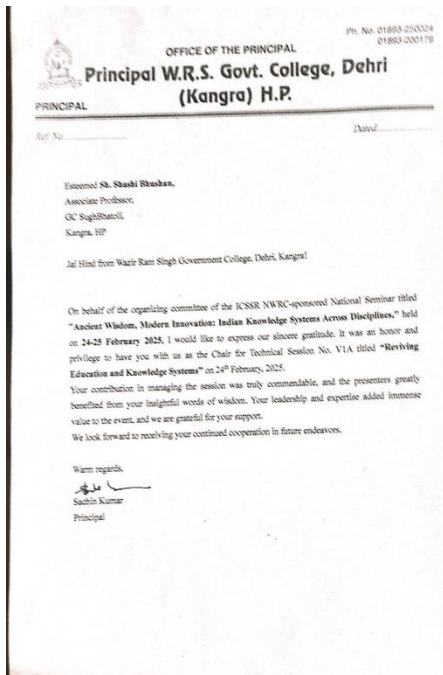

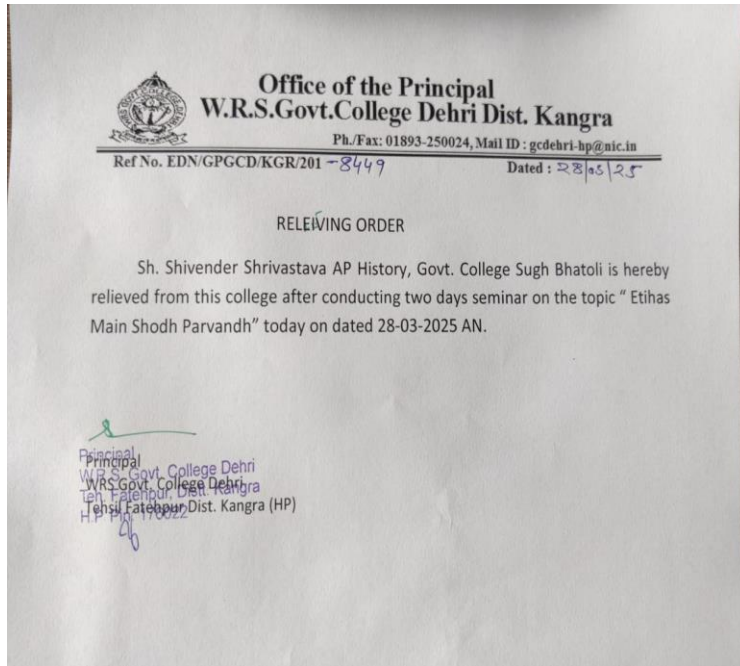
